**Audience: School Communities**

Lutheran learning communities aspire to deliver an excellent service, offer a strong workplace culture and meet the expectations of stakeholders. The NAVIGATE Survey, which in 2024 was refreshed through lens of 'Free to Flourish' is a measure of community attitudes and perceptions towards meeting these.

### **Actioning your Strategy**
